



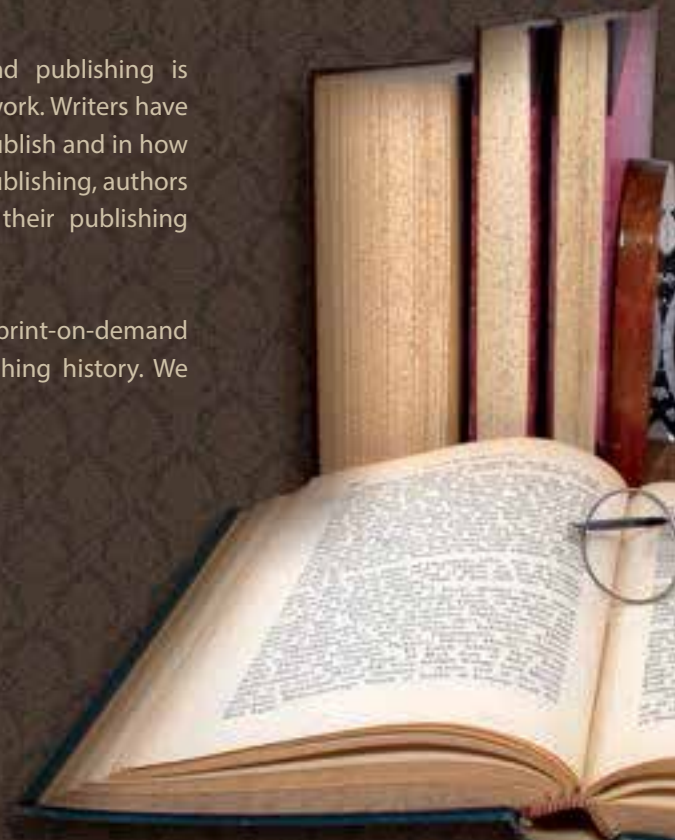

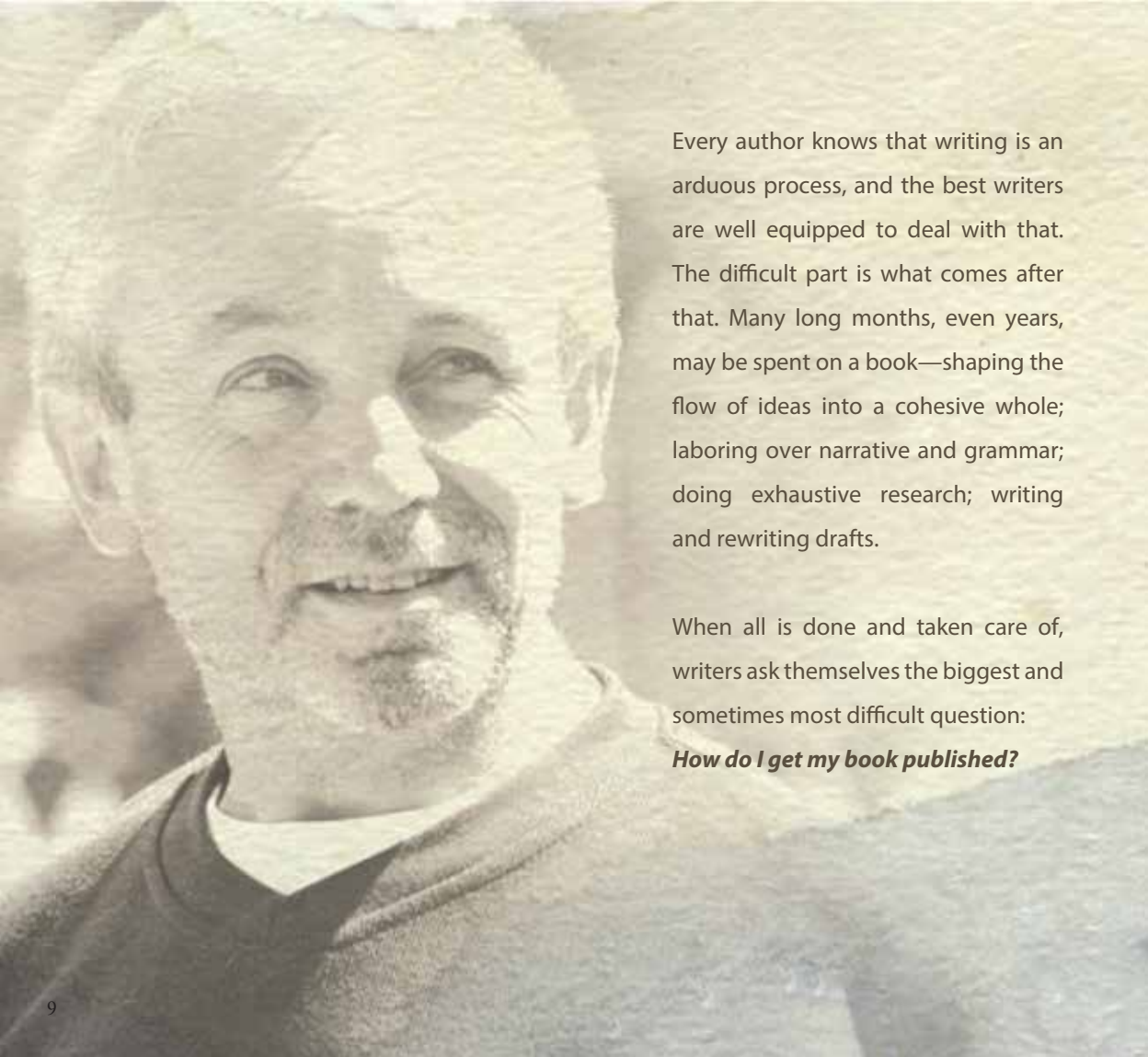

DISTRIBUTION

Once your book is published, we will make it available for order in the Trafford bookstore, Barnes & Noble.com, Amazon.com, and thousands of other retail outlets worldwide through the Ingram and Baker & Taylor book distribution networks.

Our bookselling offerings also include special author-only volume book discounts and a Booksellers Return program that alleviates risk and allows bookstores to return unsold copies of your book.

PRICING

You determine the price of your book. Some constraints apply, such as a fixed cost for the cover and page count, plus the distribution cost and royalty amount, but ultimately you establish the final book price. The cover cost and page count determine the minimum base price for the production of your book. The distribution and royalty amounts are displayed after you choose the total selling price.
